This year promises to continue the tradition of wet, hard, hilly running through the Severance wilderness. The trails are largely wide and open however, the footing ranges from hard packed gravel to logging roads to rocky, ankle twisting ground. Sections of it are always wet (some are very wet) and the course may be snow covered, so caution is advised. (Snowshoe entrants are always welcome.)

The weather has proved unpredictable: one year providing a sunny, 55 °F temperature for the start and another year offering bitter cold, wind, and snow. We will hold the race regardless of the weather. Race amenities are few (you get what you pay for) but water and a warm camp fire will be provided at the finish.

Thanksgiving is a big hunting day and the race course runs into the woods well away from roads and populated areas. Though the race is on private property marked "no hunting" wearing red, orange, or other "don't shoot me" colors is required.
